a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

To provide additional mentorship to at-risk youth in Leon, Escambia, Duval, Orange, St. Lucie, Hillsborough and Miami-Dade Counties. Funds will be used to expand access for youth to participate in after-school mentorship programs, college tours, training and development.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funding will be used to provide after-school reading, mentorship, and life changing family services to at-risk youth in high juvenile crime areas throughout Leon, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, St. Lucie, and Miami-Dade Counties.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Individual, group and family focused counseling, crisis intervention counseling, college preparatory and skills training, social skills training, prevention and diversion services, and recreational services to at-risk youth in Leon, Duval, Escambia, Hillsborough, St. Lucie and Miami-Dade Counties.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, preschool students and grade school students will be the target population served. Omega Lamplighters anticipates serving 1,318 at-risk youth during the 2019-20 fiscal year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Omega Lamplighters will focus on improving quality of education, reducing substance abuse and diverting atrisk youth from criminal & juvenile justice system. This project will increase quality of after-school reading programs, access to individual mentors and services for at-risk youth.
