11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purchase of three high water vehicles would enable first responders to provide rescue and recovery services to citizens in flooded areas of Taylor County. The county has approximately 52 miles of coastline in addition to low lying areas along rivers and estuaries which make the entire county vulnerable to flooding. Taylor County Sheriff's Office - Division of Emergency Management will receive possession of the three high water vehicles upon procurement by the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners. The Taylor County Sheriff's Office - Division of Emergency Management and the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners have an Interlocal Agreement that the Sheriff's Office will conduct operations of emergency management on behalf of Taylor County.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - These vehicles will be staged and deployed by the Sheriff's Office Division of Emergency Management at different locations throughout Taylor County to provide rescue, recovery, and needed resources to aid citizens in all areas.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - In the event of a storm surge, for citizens who are in need of rescue, recovery, and potentially life-saving resources the county would have the equipment available and necessary to provide these services.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
 Due to the majority of the county being low lying and near the Gulf, an estuary, or river the entire county would be served.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - The purchase of these vehicles would provide potentially life saving emergency rescue and recovery services.
