4. **Project/Program Description**

This project will provide construction services for the safe demolition of 50+ hazardous condemned buildings. These structures are either falling down or in such disrepair that it would not be financially feasible to repair them. In their current states, these nuisance structures are dangerous in that children sometimes play in them, vagrants sometimes congregate there, and criminals and those in the drug trade use them to conduct business. Removal of such properties will be a tremendous help to Palm Beach Sheriff's Office in keeping crime down in the area. Further, the overall beautification of the city is an effort to spur economic development and eradicate blight. Prior to funds being expended to demolish any one property, the private property owner must sign a restrictive covenant stating that the property will only be used for low-income housing for a period of five years.
