As this area floods during a storm event, curbing will direct accumulated water toward the proper drainage basins. this will alleviate flooding on this roadway. This is the main thoroughfare to over 60% of the city's population which is over 50,000 condominiums residents and will additionally provide safe roadways for several hotels, resorts and the Aventura Mall which is the 2nd largest for retail in the country.

Regular monitoring of area by city staff.

This project will provide curbing to streamline drainage in an area that floods regularly in the road and the existing dirt swale. With roadways and swales free of pooling water after rain events safe driving conditions will be met.

The benefit will be the significant reduction or elimination of roadway flooding. The outcome will be measured through site visits, photos and reports to be generated by City staff following storm events.

The City's standard contract provides for liquidated damages to be assessed to the contractor for not completing the project within the construction time frame outlined. In addition, a performance and payment bond is required from the awarded contractor.
