The Leaders Ignited For Transformation (LIFT) Initiative is a collaborative effort of statewide chapters of the 100 Black Men of America throughout Florida. Chapters are located in the following areas: Ft. Lauderdale, Jacksonville, Orlando, Pensacola, Miami, Ft. Myers, Tallahassee, and Tampa.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - Saturday Success Academy, Summer Success Academy
 - · After-School Mentoring
 - Summer Success Academy
 - STEM (Coding and Robotics)
- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
 - Coordinate programming statewide
 - Provide networked and competitive STEM programming
 - Provide more in-depth financial mentoring and offer books and other educational materials
 - · Offer seminars and resource material to parents
 - Offer additional college tours and other field trips mentees.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is African-American male students between the ages of 10-19 years of age.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - 80% attendance in Saturday Sessions
 - 80% without disciplinary actions in school
 - 75% indicated a desire to attend future sessions
 - 75% of parents surveyed indicated a positive impact on self esteem
 - 70% of mentees show improved mastery of topics discussed (via pre/post test)
 - 50% increase in grade level reading.
- f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
