١.	Program Performance
	a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	Sarasota Summer Learning Academy is a free, 6 week summer program for K-4 students in Title I schools. The program's two-generational approach involves both children and their parents. K-4 students improve English Language Arts and math proficiency, counteract the summer brain drain, and are exposed to art and cultural experiences in the afternoons lead by community partners. Parents also have the opportunity to enroll in once-a-week, evening adult education classes called "Parent University".
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	K-3 students receive academic instruction in English Language Arts and Mathematics in the morning and exposure to the arts and off-campus community activities in the afternoons. Additionally, breakfast and lunch are provided daily during the 6 week program. Parents also receive assistance through the "Parent University" where they learn strategies to assist their children's education and have the opportunity to enroll in adult education courses.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	K-3 students will receive enhanced summer instruction in English Language Arts and Mathematics, exposure to the arts and off-campus community activities, bus transportation in the mornings, and breakfast and lunch on a daily basis for the duration of the program. Parents also receive assistance through the "Parent University" where they learn strategies to assist their children's education and have the opportunity to enroll in adult education courses.
l.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	1,000 students in grades K-3 who attend Title I schools in Sarasota County.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Students who participated in the SLA program performed better on readiness assessment tests compared to their peers who did not attend SLA. Performance is measured by iReady and kindergarten "On the Mark" assessments.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Funds not used to support the Sarasota Summer Learning Academy will be returned to the state.
