a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This funding would bring Circuit 12 funding in step with the statewide average so that it can provide provide adequate services for the children and families in Sarasota, Manatee and Desoto including foster care, protective services, adoptions, prevention/diversion, substance abuse and mental

	paying for beds, housing, therapies, and wrap around services for our most vulnerable population. It will also help reduce the caseload ratios of case managers. For the last 5 years, Circuit 12 has become the most adversely affected in the state due to opioid crisis. Removal of children has more than doubled, with 70% of these children under age 5. In some instances, case managers have 50 cases.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Foster Care, Adoptions, Protective Services, Diversion, Prevention, Substance Abuse, Mental Health, Quality Assurance, training, appropriate housing, etc.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Foster Care, Adoptions, Protective Services, Diversion, Prevention, Substance Abuse, Mental Health, Quality Assurance, training, appropriate housing, etc
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The target population is children and youth ages 0-22 who are either in care and at risk of coming into care. All ages for parents, caregivers, foster parents and adoptive parents if they have a child at risk.

	Children and Families in Circuit 12 will receive the level of care other children throughout the state of Florida receive. The Department of Children and Families has hundreds of outcome measures and contract measures that all Community Based Care Organizations are held accountable for.
