Funds will be spent for the planning and update of the Stormwater Master Plan that will identify areas within the City of Doral in need of construction of additional stormwater drainage.

Areas for new stormwater drainage system will be identified to install: exfiltration trench, inlets, manholes.

This plan will be able to identify new areas within the City of Doral that require additional installation of new stormwater drainage system which would prevent ponding and flooding within the area. Project will also identify the new areas that would serve as a mitigation initiative to help prevent flood related losses.

The City of Doral includes approximately 46,000 in population, this project is city-wide.

The expected benefit will be prevention of flooding and/or ponding. The measurement will be: no flooding / ponding visible during normal rain events.
