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а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	The purpose of Equal Shot is to provide under-resourced youth in Leon County with opportunities to uncover their full potential as leaders and creative problem solvers through basketball skill training, purpose development, and skill acquisition.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Equal Shot will host an annual total of 15 training camps for youth; three camps the first quarter and four the remaining three quarters.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Equal Shot will partner with established local entities to provide services in the following three areas: basketball skill training, purpose development, and soft skill acquisition. Confirmed program partners include: Creators Camp, Total Athlete Academy, and The New Rules Project.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Equal Shot locally serves at-risk and under-resourced youth between the ages of five to eighteen. Specifically, we serve youth involved in the juvenile justice system. Up to 50 youth will participate in each training camp totaling up to 750 youth served annually.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Through our elite training camps, justice-involved youth will embrace new, pro-social trajectories for their lives, desisting from delinquent behavior and developing into prominent leaders and problem solvers in society. Our method for measuring the success of our program includes a follow-up one year post-attendance. The follow-up process also involves collecting history of the individual's recent arrest history and behavioral issues at school.
