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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

AMIkids Academic Enrichment Program puts students on track to re-enter school and earn a diploma. Based on the belief that high academic performance is influenced by quality teachers and effective instruction, this program provides a a multi-prong blended instructional approach that includes skills training, online learning, and teacher professional development. This approach meets and challenges students at their current performance level while allowing them to advance with guided support.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding will support classroom instruction and teacher professional development (PD). The model will provide blended instruction and small group and cooperative learning. The blended format provides students extended time to master concepts through actively practicing and applying the content. The PD model focuses on assessment and intervention skills teachers need to effectively teach at-risk youth.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Students will receive digital and direct instruction to enhance their reading and math skills. This will be accomplished through a blended learning environment which provides both digital and direct instruction in a small focused school environment staffed by certified and competent teachers.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Persons with poor mental health, Jobless persons, At-risk youth, Grade school students, High school students, Currently and formerly incarcerated persons, Drug offenders in criminal justice.

Between 500 and 800 students can be served by these funds.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

1. Improve quality of education - AMIkids will measure the number of course completions, credits earned, GED or diplomas awarded based on FL middle school matriculation and high school graduation requirements as well as grade level increase per STAR Renaissance assessment.

2. Protect the general public from harm - AMIkids will monitor daily attendance of all students enrolled in the program

3. Increase specific individual's economic self sufficiency - AMIkids will track the number of GEDs and/or HS diplomas awarded across all programs
