	The target population to be served by this project are the local communities, state institutions, organizations seeking and needing historical information and services, as well as the tourists and visitors to those institutions. We expect to serve thousands of individuals across the state of Florida as well as the entire country as visitors come from many different places to seek historical research.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	While we expect many benefits from this project, specifically, we expect to enrich the cultural experience which is demonstrated through audience and production data from the site visits, exhibits, and events. The quality of education will be improved through heritage lessons and programs where surveys are given to participants to monitor the increase in cultural awareness. FAAHPN will improve economic activity through increased business spending which is shown in third party conducted surveys, invoices, and financial reports. Increased tourism is demonstrated through the number of tours conducted and visitations. Lastly, FAAHPN creates job opportunities and improves an individual's economic self sufficiency by creating and retaining jobs by providing salaries documented by human resource records and reports.
