To provide potable water to residents through a centralized and permitted water system to residents who are currently served by private wells. Safe and reliable potable water will ensure that the risk for waterborne diseases is less likely to occur from a permitted water treatment plant than unregulated private wells. As such, the residents' public health will be enhanced. In addition, roadway restoration, driveways, and fire suppression systems will be provided with this project. Funding will provide for the installation of an 8-inch water main and service lines to provide clean water to the resident of Country Club Ranches who are currently served by private wells.

The goal is to provide the residents of Country Club Ranches potable water through a centralized and permitted water system.

The installation of 8 inch water main and service lines to provide clean water to the resident of Country Club Ranches who are currently served by private wells. Thus reducing the risk of waterborne diseases from their private wells and improve quality of life

Clean Potable water is the direct service that will be provided to the citizens.

The project will ensure that all residents are provided with safe and clean potable water that meets the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA)[42 U.S.C. §300f et seq. (1974)]. The outcome will be measured by the standard outlined in the SDWA and the State of Florida requirement
