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а.	Program Performance What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	The project will provide the City and it's partners with plans for the project that will promote resiliency and flood prevention due to to tidal surge.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Funding will be used for preliminary resiliency reviews with Federal, State and Local Agencies along with neighbors and other possible interest groups. These reviews will identify possible partner agencies for funding, constructing and operating the gate and pump structure.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	The area contains all or portions of the Cities of Fort Lauderdale, Oakland Park and Wilton Manors.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The structure would benefit the areas within the C-13 East and North Fork of the Middle River Drainage Basins. This covers an area of about 6.5 square miles; a population of around 39,000; with a market value of \$3.5 Billion.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The outcome of the project will be the development of partnership between federal, state and local agencies. In addition, plans and permitting will be completed. These deliverables will then be used for construction of the project at a later date.
