а.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?		
	A new, centrally located library that would also serve as a pre- and post-disaster shelter is needed in Wakulla County. The library		
	plays an important part in the community by providing meeting rooms, classes, training, and events that are not provided elsewhere.		

Due to population growth and success of the library, the current facility is not adequate. A new library would also be constructed as a pre- and post-disaster risk shelter for Wakulla County visitors, citizens, and evacuees from other counties.

b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	The new facility would serve as a library providing traditional and non-traditional services and provide pre- and post-disaster high-risk shelter for citizens and visitors.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	The new facility would serve as a library providing traditional and non-traditional services and provide pre- and post-disaster high-risk shelter for citizens and visitors.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	This project will benefit all citizens, visitors, and potential evacuees to Wakulla County. Approximately 800 individuals or more are expected to be served.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	1. Enrich cultural experience and improve quality of education by providing classes and activities for all ages to expand and enhance cultural knowledge and experiences not otherwise provided or available in the county. 2. To improve agricultural production/promotion/education by providing a teaching garden and chicken coops to provide basic education and experience with basic farm to table experiences. 3. Protect the general public from harm (i.e. environmental, criminal, etc.) by having the county provide pre- and post-disaster shelter when needed. The method for measuring the level of benefit or outcome will be measured by the number of classes/activities and number of participants and the number of evacuees served at/from the facility.
