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#### 11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The renovations will provide accessibility to the park for all ages and abilities. In addition, renovations to the playground will provide added safety measures to a facility in critical need of renovation that is heavily used year round.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The renovation of Southside Park will provide for a safe, accessible playground and park for the many families and children who live in nearby neighborhoods who do not have access to any other public parks in the area.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Access to outdoor recreation in a safe and accessible environment. The improvements will also provide direct access to a 3 mile trail known as the "Old Dixie Highway Trail" which will be under construction by late 2020. Citizens will have numerous active and passive recreation options.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Southside Park is open to all citizens with the target population being families and children in the nearby neighborhoods. Many of these families are low income and do not have direct access to any other public recreation facilities. 5,000+ will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will provide for a safe playground and much needed basketball courts which are currently unusable due to being in disrepair. The sidewalk renovation will provide accessibility to all citizens. Southside Park will again be the once thriving park site it has been for more than 50 years.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

The county has obtained price quotes and has a completed a conceptual plan for the park renovation. The county will move forward with the project immediately upon receipt of funding. The county will meet all deliverables and timelines in the contract.
