Funds would be used to reconstruct NE 153rd St and NE 21st Avenue by providing increased accessibility for users. Construction work will include sidewalks, constructing curb and gutters to improve drainage, and provide a safer driving surface by re-paving the roadway. This area currently does not have sidewalks or curbing and the roadway pavement has deteriorated. The proposed improvements will improve safety and ADA accessibility. The project proposes to construct sidewalks, ADA ramps, curbs, gutters, and repaving of the roadway.

The funds would be used to reconstruct NE 153rd St and NE 21st Avenue by providing increased accessibility for users. Construction work will include new sidewalks, improved drainage (by constructing curbs and gutters) and also a better driving surface by re-paving of the roadway.

This project will be for the construction of new sidewalk, curbing, drainage, and pavement improvement.
