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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Firearm proficiency is just one of many necessary skills needed to ensure the safety of the community and fellow law enforcement. Having a gun range in Cape Coral will greatly increase officers' firearms training hours, which will result in increased confidence and proficiency in firearms, all the while, training within the City limits. This includes our School Resource Officers (SROs) who are limited on when they can train as they must train when school is not in session. It is imperative that the SROs are proficient and confident in their firearm skills in today's climate.

The Public Safety Gun Range, will not only benefit the City of Cape Coral, but it will benefit law enforcement agencies throughout Southwest Florida, providing another gun range to train at, potentially increasing training hours and proficiency for officers at all levels, federal, state and local, throughout

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

By increasing the number of firearms training hours for officers at all levels, increases their proficiency and confidence in their abilities during high stress situations. Local law enforcement agencies will have better trained officers due to the fact that sworn personnel will have the opportunity to train more frequently. This includes above and beyond the requirements needed to meet the qualifications standards.

Cape Coral officers will be able to train within the City limits to respond to calls immediately to include but not limited to: SWAT call-outs, active shooter situations, school threats and/or shootings, officer involved shootings, and natural disasters. As apposed to training at a minimum 45 minutes outside the City limits.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Department's vision is to become the premier law enforcement agency in Florida, striving to attain the highest level of safety of our community. Citizens rely on law enforcement to protect and serve the community. Having sworn personnel, with the skills, knowledge, and abilities, to handle a high stress situation means better protection for the general public, including our youth in schools.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The general public, including grade schools, middle schools, and high schools – According to the U.S. Census 2018 estimate, the Cape Coral's population is 189,343.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

By increasing the number of firearms training hours for officers at all levels, increases their proficiency and confidence in their abilities during highstress situations. Local law enforcement agencies will have better-trained officers; sworn personnel will have the opportunity to train more frequently. This includes above and beyond the requirements needed to meet the qualifications standards.
