u.	The goal of the this project would be to increase water volume along the NW/SW 1 Avenue corridor for the purpose of increasing fire protection and providing water for economic development.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
D.	Design and construction of 12 inch water mains.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	The citizens and businesses in the area will have greater water flow and increased fire protection from more fire hydrants and greater water volume.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The whole utility customer base will benefit by not having to fund these upgrades. Due to the small customer base and current debt burden from a new filtration plant, there is a scarce water utility revenue available for repairs in other parts of the water system. The community will benefit from greater economic development resulting from replacing 1 and 2 story 1950's style building with new multistory structures.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The benefit is new 12-inch water mains and increased water volume in the downtown area. The number of new pipes will be measured in linear feet, and water flow rates will measure from the hydrants in gallons/minute.
