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1.	Program Performance
a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	Request \$410,000 in nonrecurring funding to ensure the long-term viability of Manatee Educational Television. This funding will allow METV to upgrade outdated equipment and move into a new studio in Building 8 on the SCF Bradenton Campus. METV will be integrated into the Communications and Marketing Department of SCF.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	The requested funds will ensure the viability of Manatee Educational Television, a highly valued community resource in Manatee County. METV will relocate to a new studio on the Bradenton Campus of the State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota, and become part of the College. The replacement of out-dated equipment will allow METV to produce high quality broadcast products for on line and local access viewing.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	METV will continue to provide television coverage of county activities and local non-profit organizations to keep Manatee County residents informed about local government, community events and culture.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	METV provides broadcast services of public meetings and events to all residents of Manatee County for informational and educational purposes. Residents of all ages benefit from this service.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	METV provides television coverage of county activities and local non-profit organizations to keep Manatee County residents informed about local government, community events and culture. SCF's Communications and Marketing Department will use advanced social media metrics to measure viewership. SCF students will participate in internships at METV in support of workforce multimedia certificates and degrees, resulting in an increase of SCF students completing internships.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
