a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Having more US students to have access to the mandarin language learning, and thus promoting mutual understanding between two cultures in the long term. Another benefit is to help improve the imbalance of mandarin language learning resource distributions. A growing trend of demands in mandarin

language learning is observed in the past decade.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Offering monthly programs and various learning opportunities by hosting on weekend, online, and classroom environments.

Various types of programs will be offered to cater to different learning needs and age groups, including Express Chinese Program, Language & Culture Study Tour, and a Mandarin Summer Camp.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The program is suitable for learners who want to study Chinese intensively for the long term (3 months or longer). Classes are available to learners of all levels, from beginner to advance.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

High school students and university/college Students. Up to 400 students to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A growing trend of demands in Mandarin language is observed in the past decades. Systematic operations of the Mandarin Training Center in collaboration with Florida A&M University can be a start to help with learning resource imbalance. The program will be tracked by the student's ability to learn the language.
