### 4. **Project/Program Description**

On July 6, 2019, when the Market on University had an explosion the City of Plantation did not have an incident command mobile vehicle to efficiently handle the command responsibilities that were required for this unfortunate incident. The mobile incident command vehicle will give the City of Plantation Police and Fire Departments and surrounding local governments the ability to efficiently: 1) set up a command center for any emergency event within the city and any of the surrounding cities that do not have an incident command mobile unit; 2) obtain critical information in a central place and therefore effectively handle the emergency; and 3) expedite the presence of a command center rather than wait for a neighboring entity for equipment, if it is not in use.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

After the July 6, 2019, explosion, the City of Plantation did not have the adequate equipment to efficiently handle the command responsibilities that were involved with this unfortunate incident. If there is another similar incident and neighboring agencies cannot share resources, the city will be challenged to adequately handle its command responsibilities efficiently. The city does not have the funds to procure this necessary equipment.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The mobile incident command would give the City of Plantation Police and Fire Departments the ability to efficiently set up a proper command center for any emergency event within the city and any of the surrounding cities that do not have a mobile command unit.

The ability to obtain critical information in a central place and therefore, effectively handle the emergency.
