Learning with Dignity purpose is to ensure students have access to menstrual necessities during school hours by stocking menstrual products in girls and gender-neutral bathrooms. For so long laws have required our schools to keep every restroom maintained and cleared regularly, fully operational, and stocked with soap and paper supplies. Yet female students who unexpectedly get their periods in school may not have menstrual products available, or they may not have those supplies with them in the bathroom. Girls often miss instructional time or are forced to leave school due to the lack of access to feminine hygiene necessities.
