4. **Project/Program Description**

The existing Central Park multi-purpose building houses the Parks & Recreation Department's administrative staff and includes a small exercise room, game room, single basketball court gymnasium, general-purpose locker rooms, modest office space for aquatics program staff, a few small classrooms, modest storage rooms, and customary restroom facilities. The existing 37-year-old building does not meet current program and staffing needs forcing staff to implement makeshift solutions for daily operations. Noise from daily activities in the building impacts administrative staff, making for very difficult working conditions. The existing building layout and access to the building does not permit efficient operation for programs in the building or the aquatics program. Planned expansion of programs will only worsen these conditions.

There will be an exercise room, game room, dance/aerobics room, women's and men's locker rooms, and a kitchen and lounge in the activity center. The gymnasium can house summer camps and various sport tournaments.
