1. **Project Title** Calhoun County Search and Rescue Building2. **Senate Sponsor** Bill Montford3. **Date of Request** 11/05/20194. **Project/Program Description**

Hurricane Michael severely damaged or destroyed all VFD locations, with the Carr-Clarksville VFD firehouse serving the central western section of Calhoun County, and also serving as the base of operations and training area for County Search & Rescue (S&R) activities, being completely destroyed. Fire engines, brush trucks, and related equipment are now housed at our volunteer firefighter's homes until new facilities can be constructed, with S&R coordination being conducted at their homes as well. First response and S&R efforts are severely hampered due to the lack of centralized operations, the loss and degradation of equipment and supplies from the storm, and the theft of supplies from multiple fire departments after the storm. The county desires to build a larger, modern, and hardened firehouse capable of housing essential county staff and volunteers during future severe weather events in order to better serve the community
