The project is intended to eliminate remaining Village septic tanks and replace with sanitary sewer service, including all necessary system and pump station modification. Would increase sanitary health of surrounding properties and also environmentally redirecting pollutants from entering the C-51 canal that leads to the intracoastal waterway and other vital water resources. Would also increase property values for this lower socio-economic community in which 96% of residents live in workforce housing.


