Proper flood mitigation, which is essential to community health and the safety of people and property. This project will build on the Phase 1 improvements to better protect the community, primarily workforce housing the area to be protected.

Improve the culvert capacity at Cutlass Drive. Improve the capacity of the Hopkins Creek ditch via rehabilitation and widening.

Protection of homes and property from flooding after heavy rainfall and tropical events.

Approximately 1,500 residents, including those who live in the 130 homes that flooded in November 2015.
