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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Sarasota County is located on the southwest coast of Florida; one of the most vulnerable areas of the U.S. coast to hurricanes and associated surge.

	Geographically, the areas from Osprey through Venice and southward down to Englewood are extremely low-lying and vulnerable to storm surge; therefore, there are no shelters in these areas. Funding for this project will specifically add additional shelter space in an area with limited shelter capacity, reduce travel time and improve evacuation timing to shelters for a vulnerable area, reduce logistical and operational support required through emergency management to support evacuation from those areas, and increase shelter space to assist with the host evacuation sheltering within Sarasota County. It will also offer dedicated space, available at any time, to support shelter operations locally, regionally, and statewide for any type of disaster.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	This request will fund the design and construction of an approximately 35,000 sq. EHPA shelter to remain available for use at any time throughout the year to support shelter operations. When not used for sheltering, the building will support citizen engagement for indoor sports, meeting, and ancillary support spaces.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	This project will directly impact the citizens throughout Sarasota County by adding an additional 1,000 shelter spaces. More specifically, the project will provide shelter space in an area of mid-county that does not currently have shelter space because of vulnerabilities to storm surge and flooding. This building will also provide the ability for the county to continue to serve residents in a post storm setting. Currently, all of the county risk shelters are located in schools, which will need to be vacated post-storm to allow school to resume. This shelter will allow continued care for either special needs or general population evacuees who may not be able to return to their homes. Additionally, this shelter would be available to assist other communities when Sarasota is not an impact county.
l.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	All citizens of Sarasota County; however, the mid-county area is primarily an older community with difficulty driving. This shelter would reduce barriers to senior citizens moving to risk sheltering space during disasters.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	This project will support all citizens with specific support to citizens located in mid-county who do not have shelter space in their area because of extensive low-lying areas and vulnerabilities to storm surge. It will improve shelter deficits within the county and provide additional support to the state and other communities when needed. The methodology utilized is consistent with the statewide shelter study completed by the Florida Division of Emergency Management.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
	Funding could be withheld for any items that failed to meet deliverable or performance measures.
