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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

	The expansion of the road network in the Tradition Center for Commerce will provide access to an additional 108 acres and facilitate the relocation and expansion of QTI companies to the city's jobs corridor.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	The construction and CEI inspections for a 2,580 linear foot roadway including water, sewer, and electric utilities that will be located in the Tradition Center for Commerce which is located in the city's jobs corridor.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Connectivity of a road network in the Tradition Center for Commerce that provides access to an additional 108 acres of vacant land in the city's jobs corridor.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Employees and visitors to the Tradition Center of Commerce (City Electric Supply, Keiser University, Oculus Surgical, Somerset Academy Charter School, and Accel International). Residents of proposed multi-family units and consumers of proposed retail stores and restaurants.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	The proposed roadway, including drainage and utility service improvements, will serve ±133 acres and provide direct access to an additional ±108 acres of vacant land that can accommodate an estimated 1,606,905 square feet of commercial development and generate over 2,473 new jobs in the Tradition Center for Commerce in the City of Port St. Lucie. The expected benefit is the retention and attraction of QTI companies to the Tradition Center for Commerce. The benefits will be measured based on the number of companies retained or attracted, the amount of capital investment, and the number of existing jobs retained and new jobs created in the Tradition Center for Commerce which is located in the city's jobs corridor.

	Returning funds to the state.
