14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The goal is to complete and operate the Miami Lakes Multipurpose Senior Activity and Community Center to enhance the physical and emotional well-being of Miami Lakes seniors. Funds will achieve the utilities, electrical, fixtures, equipment, and interior build scope of services. This Senior Activity and Community Center will be the Town's main, multi-purpose senior center, providing vital health, fitness, and wellness programs and services; civic engagement opportunities; language, educational, and arts programs; community resources and elderly assistance; free ADA accessible Freebee transportation; and vital support services to the elderly community.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities include the utilities, electrical, fixtures, equipment, and interior build scope of services. Over 5,000 of the Miami Lakes adult population are seniors. The intended purpose of the Project is to provide seniors with health, fitness, and wellness programs and services; civic engagement opportunities; language, educational, and arts programs; and vital resources and elderly assistance. The Miami Lakes Multipurpose Senior Activity and Community Center will be the Town's main, multi-purpose senior center, offering vital programs and services to the elderly community and local Veterans of Miami Lakes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This Project will be the Town's main, multi-purpose senior center, offering vital programs, health and wellness services, social services referrals, healthy nutritional meals, physical fitness activities, social enrichment and interaction, educational and language programs, free ADA accessible Freebee transportation, and vital support services to the elderly community and local Veterans of Miami Lakes.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served by this project are over 5,000 Miami Lakes seniors, 630 veterans, and the general senior community.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Town is a Member of the AARP Age-Friendly Communities Network and this project is a necessity for the seniors of Miami Lakes. The expected outcome is to complete the utilities, electrical, fixtures, equipment, and interior build scope of services for the senior community center. This project benefits to seniors and veterans include enhanced physical health through nutritional meals, fitness and wellness programs, improved mental health by connecting older adults to vital community services that can assist them stay healthy and independent, enriched cultural experience through providing peer engagement and cultural events and classes, and enhanced protection from harm through providing hurricane/disaster relief services; water, ice, and sandbags distribution for seniors. Methodology by which this outcome will be measured include enrollment forms, attendance, participation, data, and surveys.
