### 4. Project/Program Description

The project will reroute CR 210, south branch, including the design, construction, and inspection of approach embankments, westbound US 1 overpass, access ramps to US 1, and closure of grade crossing of Florida East Coast Railway (FEC). FDOT has completed conceptual design and additional ROW acquisition is not anticipated. The project will improve safety along a strategic railway corridor and reduce vehicle trip times, traffic congestion, and railway freight delays.

### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



The project eliminates an at-grade railway crossing that endangers the safe transportation of freight and passengers by rail. The improvements will also decrease congestion, reduce crashes, and total lost time at this intersection along the US 1 corridor with additional capacity for anticipated growth in the area.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Programmed funds will be used as match to a Railroad Crossing Elimination grant program to alleviate safety concerns through closure of an at-grade railroad crossing and rerouting of traffic through an overpass.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services provided to citizens will be through provision of a safer way to connect between US 1 and County Road 210 and removal of a dangerous at-grade railroad crossing.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General public traveling on US 1, County Road 210 and Florida Eastcoast Railway operators. Expected to serve >2,000.

# e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected Outcomes: 1) Safety: Crash data review at the intersection after the improvements are completed.

2) Level of Service: Decrease in congestion and total lost time.

3) Rail/Freight: Benefits are achieved in total at the completion of the project as removing the railroad crossing eliminates the potential for collisions. Therefore, a measurement is not applicable.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If there is a performance deficiency requiring correction by the County, Agency will notify County. County will provide Agency with a corrective action plan describing how County will address performance deficiencies. If the corrective action plan implementation fails to remedy deficiencies, Agency will retain two point five percent (2.5%) of the total appropriations amount.
