These funds were used for administrative expenses, COVID-19 testing and contact tracing, food distribution, housing support, improvement of telework for employees, nursing home assistance, payroll for Public Health and Safety employees. expenses, and small business assistance. FEMA funding was received in the amount of \$275,393 for a City-run COVID-19 vaccination site.

The expected benefit is an increase in physical activity and environmental education for citizens. Outcomes will be measured by a survey of the visitors to the Everglades Greenway Loop.
