The work will integrate the City's current and future needs and integrate FDOT's planned SR50 bypass and expansion while putting considerations into alternative water supply, parks, walking and bike trails and integrating stormwater ponds as features of the future downtown commercial district.

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Design/construct to repair and improve downtown stormwater conveyance and treatment in their downtown CRA district, and help provide parks, walking and bike trails, and integrating stormwater ponds as features of the future downtown commercial district.

Parks, walking and bike trails, as well as an Ecological Preserve to be used for an educational tool for school activities and perhaps a public access park for bird watching, picnicking, and other such activities.

To repair and improve stormwater conveyance and treatment in their downtown CRA district, and provide an ecological preserve/park for downtown commercial district.
