Dr. Guy Harvey, his Foundation, and their partners are dedicated to promoting environmental education and career pathway programming and experiences aimed at K-12 public school students in Bay County District Schools. Despite the geographic proximity of Florida's panhandle to coastal habitats, many students in this region have never seen the ocean, been on a boat, or understand the interconnected relationship they have with these natural resources. Bay County District Schools are currently using GHF STEAM curriculum in partnership with GHF through funding by The St. Joe Community Foundation. Our goal is to provide curriculum-related hands-on learning opportunities through engaging field trip experiences for these K-12 students.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



The purpose and goal of this funding will be to provide quality hands-on experiences using the GHF curriculum in STEAM for all students in Bay County with GHF and GHF Habitats. GHF partners with regional environmental education centers in Florida as "GHF Habitats" to provide curriculum-related hands-on learning opportunities for engaging field trip experiences for students. Funding for this program will cover the cost of program/admission, transportation, and lunch expenses related to field trip experiences for students within Bay County allowing students to "get salty" as they experience the natural marine resources around them, perhaps for the first time.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

With this funding we will provide students with the transportation, meals, and experiences to open them up to thinking about careers in STEAM.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This will not only enhance our public school education, but also bring students and their families to habitats and attractions in the Bay County area, further strengthening our communities. Some of these students may have never been given the opportunity to experience their local natural resources.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Our target population is the K-12 Bay County District Schools which includes 45 schools and centers, and serves over 26,000 students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This program will enable all students, especially underserved students, the opportunity to visit local environmental education centers and parks as they, perhaps for the first time, engage in hands-on STEAM programming and learn about career pathways related to this educational experience.
