The funds will enable proactive school shooter detection before shots are fired, saving time and lives. Schools are difficult to protect since they have large exterior spaces, many entry points, and limited resources for security technology and security personnel. ZeroEyes' active shooter detection technology uses artificial intelligence on existing security cameras to provide first responders with clear, accurate, and timely information, enabling them to respond more quickly and effectively.

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The funds will be used to detect and respond to active shooters: 1) Expansion of continuous operation, testing, and improvement of the video analytic software that detects school shooters on to 5000 cameras. 2) Expansion of continuous human-verified monitoring to ensure only verified alerts reach the end use.
