	The bulkhead at Lakeside Park is in very poor condition showing signs of deterioration and requires replacement. It simply has so many deficiencies that repair is not feasible. The replacement will be necessary to maintain needed infrastructure that will preserve the park and prevent impacts to water access and residential properties that share the canal. This seawall is clearly at or near the end of its useful life, and could suffer a structural failure at any time, especially during a sever rain event or during a sudden recession of the water level in the Lake Wor Lagoon. The seawall/bulkhead is located in the south end of the Lakeside Park. Lakeside Park is a unique recreational site located directly on the Lake Worth Lagoon. The park is situated among a residential community. As one of the most popular outdoor destinations in the area, the Village has made the renovation of the park a priority.

At the north end, it returns to the west approximately 37 feet and at the south end, it runs approximately 171 feet along the north side of a man made canal to the west property line of the park.
