The focus of the tennis center will be youth activities and play. While the center is open to all ages, reaching the young / disadvantaged people is the primary goal. The indoor facility can host events ranging from graduation ceremonies, trade shows, and athletic events. The additional hard courts will allow the center to host additional high-level tournaments.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Exposure to many different people, opportunity to play a sport that can improve physical outcomes, and attend tennis tournaments and events.

The SVB Tennis Center's mission statement clarifies the goals: "to provide tennis and education in underserved communities with a focus on youth to instill character, leadership, nutrition, and academics." Hundreds of individuals are expected to be served annually.
