14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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To stimulate economic development in a quickly growing part of Pasco by constructing a regional park and development of a wetland system to clean stormwater and pollutants while educating the public on the valuable role of water in Florida. The location provides a needed connection to downtown Zephyrhills while promoting the economic development expansion of the business area, the park will provide a catalyst for private sector investment in the area. Zephyr Park will meet the needs of many with its unique design and will draw visitors and investors to the opportunities within Pasco County.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The mission of the Zephyr Lake Park is to enrich our community through nature, culture, recreation, and education. The park serves to unify the city's diverse population, offering public spaces that will serve the needs of many by providing engaging and diverse opportunities in education and recreation. Interpretative elements along the lake will show visitors how pollution can be prevented from entering waterways by cleaning stormwater runoff. The children's area is designed to let a kid have fun, running and playing in water, enjoying the incredible tree canopy or engaging in hands on learning about the ecology of Florida.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Located in the city's urban area creates a prime opportunity to provide educational exhibits highlighting the sensitive role of water in Florida, the arts along with the area's agricultural, industrial, and cultural assets. The park will also serve as a place to connect people socially with the large central event lawn for concerts and festivals. The range of activities planned for the park will support physical and social equity for all park visitors in an effort to reinforce shared experiences and forge new connections within this growing and changing community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Zephyr Lake Park will welcome and serve visitors of all ages and backgrounds from throughout the Pasco, Hillsborough, and Polk Counties area and connect neighborhoods with new walking and biking paths. The park will be designed to meet and engage the needs of thousands of visitors each month. The park will provide hands on engagement focusing on our natural environment highlighting water in Florida.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Zephyr Lake Park will promote physical and mental health for all ages. Studies show parks attract non-resident visitors who put new dollars into the local economy. Proximity to parks enhances the value of residential and commercial properties. Success will be measured by participation in events and programs and the increase in land value surrounding the park.
