#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To provide mental and behavioral health counseling and services to approximately 400 students, grades 6-12 in Palm Beach County Schools.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Mental and Behavioral Health Counseling and Services will be provided to approximately 500 students, grades 6-12 in Palm Beach County Public Schools. 1:1 Mental Health Counseling, Small and Large Group Counseling Services, and Diagnostic and Developmental Screening and Assessment.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
- 1:1 Mental Health Counseling to individuals experiencing hard life events and students with identified emotional disabilities. Small and large group counseling aimed at tier I, tier II and tier III students needing support, including direct screening and identification of students needing behavioral and/or mental health services using data from evaluations.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Persons with poor mental health, at-risk youth, developmentally disabled, grade school students, high school students, and victims of crime.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
- (1) Improved Mental Health: Decrease in anxiety and depression, improvement in overall academic performance with focused trauma informed care interventions and strategies, augmenting development of peer and social relationships and resiliency as well as coping strategies related to online activities. The Presence therapy platform includes Progress Tracker platform, enabling streamlined reporting and communication to review student progress by all parties. (2) Improve quality of education: Decreased anxiety and depression resulting in quantifiable progress with overall academic performance and measured reductions in overall disciplinary actions, all measured by Social-Emotional, Behavioral and Functional Behavioral Assessments and Manifestation Determination, applied periodically to measure short to medium to longterm success rates.
- f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contracting agency may consider liquidated damages based on a monthly audit after a written warning outlining the items that fail to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract has been discussed. If after 1 month a financial deduction would occur in the amount of \$1,000 per month until remediation has been achieved.
