  - a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The goal of this project is to provide essential services to various community members promoting health and wellness, senior activities, and support for those suffering from chronic diseases. Community partnerships will allow for medical integration as a compliment to fitness classes, social activities, and educational seminars.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Healthy Living/Senior center would serve as a central hub for South Collier residents. The activities and services provided include health, fitness, and wellness programs, as well as mental health services. Additionally, the senior center would provide nutritional support, educational seminars, volunteer opportunities, and social and recreational activities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wellness classes geared towards seniors such as yoga, tai chi, mindful movement, etc. An activities room would provide a space for groups to gather, socialize, and play games. Community partnerships will be utilized to promote medical integration options such as physical therapy, cognitive assessments, weight and nutrition programs, strength training, and chronic disease support classes.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

As a hub provider of essential health and wellness services in Collier County, our target population includes all members of the community. However, this facility would have an emphasis on senior activities, chronic disease support classes, social and mental wellness programs, and medical integration through partnerships.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A healthy living facility would allow for a larger community impact as additional programs, activities, and classes will be available for the diverse population that coexist in Collier County. Increasing available space will also foster expanding partnerships thus providing an ease of access for a variety of essential services that are currently unavailable.
