The Rural Satellite Broadband project will provide 425 families, small businesses, and other organizations in Gulf County immediate access to 100 mbps high speed, low latency, reliable internet service from Starlink satellite service to underserved rural and remote households, small businesses, educational and public facilities, and non-profit organizations who are in considerable need of broadband where fiber options are not possible. The project will provide satellite broadband service technology and one year of service to selected households, businesses, health care facilities, and other organizations selected for service.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



The goal of these funds will provide families, small businesses, and other organizations immediate access to 100 mbps high speed, low latency, reliable satellite internet service to underserved rural and remote households, small businesses, educational and public facilities, or non-profit organizations in Gulf County who are in considerable need of broadband where fiber options are not possible. The project will provide satellite technology and one year of service.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

With these funds, Gulf County will deploy 425 Starlink Satellite dishes and one year of service to residents, businesses, and organizations that do not currently have reliable high speed broadband service. The funds will provide immediate broadband service to these residents and businesses.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This satellite broadband project will provide immediate highspeed internet service to these residents and businesses in areas where fiber broadband connections are not installed and may be years from installation. The satellite service will be easy to connect, easy to use, provide extremely high quality 100 mbps internet service to areas that do not have quality internet connections. It will increase educational outcomes, business opportunities, social connections, and access to the wider world.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is homes with students and elderly, businesses with poor internet connectivity, health care facilities, schools, churches, and other organizations across Gulf County. The project will provide 400 satellite dishes serving multiple households, businesses, and others as well as 25 high-performance dishes that can serve up to 30 employees in a building

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

High speed broadband in these areas will allow for telehealth visits and monitoring for citizens that may lack close access to health care or medical services; allow students and parents to access information and skills otherwise unavailable; allow businesses access to information, sales opportunities, marketing, and customer interaction via the internet which would otherwise be unavailable. Funds are provided to contract for evaluation of impact of satellite broadband project after installation. Starlink will evaluate use and effectiveness as well.
