A student, and the viewing of pictures or motion pictures that teach about disease, 18 19 conflict with the religious teachings of the child's religious 20 affiliation, is exempt from such instruction; and a child so 21 exempted may not be penalized by reason of that exemption. 22 Course descriptions for comprehensive health education shall not interfere with the local determination of appropriate 23 curriculum which reflects local values and concerns. 24 25 Section 2.
