fire officials when performing firesafety inspections of public educational and ancillary plants and educational facilities. In accordance with such standards, each board shall prescribe policies and procedures establishing a comprehensive program of safety and sanitation for the protection of occupants of public educational and ancillary plants. Such policies must contain procedures for periodic inspections as prescribed herein and for withdrawal of any educational and ancillary plant, or portion thereof, from use until unsafe or unsanitary conditions are corrected or removed. (7) ANNUAL REPORT. -- The State Fire Marshal shall publish an annual report to be filed with the substantive committees of the state House of Representatives and Senate having jurisdiction over education, the Commissioner of Education or his or her successor, and the Governor documenting the status of each board's firesafety program, including the improvement or lack thereof.
