Notwithstanding the applicable rules of discovery, all documentation that will be offered as evidence at 18 19 an administrative hearing on a Medicaid overpayment must be 20 exchanged by all parties at least 14 days before the 21 administrative hearing or must be excluded from consideration. 22 The documentation or data that a provider may rely upon or 23 present as evidence that an overpayment has not occurred must 24 have been created prior to the start of any agency 25 investigation, and must be made available to the agency

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
