768.1258 Drywall Liability Act.-

Property owners, contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, or other installers of drywall will not be liable for defective drywall causing personal injury or damage to property unless the property owners, contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, or other installers knew or should have known that the drywall was



13	defective. The provisions of this section shall apply to any
14	complaint filed after January 1, 2009. This section does not
15	apply to manufacturers of defective drywall.
