Between lines 429 and 430

insert:

(4) Each public airport operating in this state shall, to the greatest extent practicable, collect aluminum beverage cans and recyclable plastic and glass from the airlines and other entities doing business at the airport and offer such materials for recycling. Each airport may retain and use any proceeds received from the sale of these materials for recycling to offset the costs associated with collecting and recycling such materials.
