A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the University of South Florida St. Petersburg; authorizing the Board of Trustees of the University of South Florida to increase the aggregate sum of activity and service, health, and athletic fees to exceed the 5 percent cap on annual increases for the purpose of increasing the activity and service fee at the University of South Florida St. Petersburg; requiring that revenue from the increase in the activity and service fee be used to construct and operate a multipurpose campus center on the University of South Florida St. Petersburg campus; requiring that any proposed increase in the fee be approved by the activity and service fee committee; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding s. 1009.24(4)(d), Florida

Statutes, the Board of Trustees of the University of South

Florida may increase the aggregate sum of activity and service,
health, and athletic fees to exceed the 5 percent cap on annual
increases to such fees for the 2010-2011 fiscal year for the
purpose of increasing the activity and service fee at the
University of South Florida St. Petersburg. Revenue generated by
the increase in the activity and service fee shall be used to
construct and operate a multipurpose campus center on the
University of South Florida St. Petersburg campus. Any proposed
increase in the fee must be approved by the university's
