Section 57. Section 322.145, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

322.145 Electronic authentication of licenses.-

(1) Any driver's licenses issued on or after July 1, 2012, may contain a means of electronic authentication that conforms to a recognized standard for such authentication, such as public key infrastructure, symmetric key algorithms, security tokens, mediametrics, or biometrics. Electronic authentication capabilities must not interfere with or change the driver's



license format or topology.

- (2) The department may provide, at the applicant's option and at the time a license is issued, a security token that can be electronically authenticated through a personal computer. The token must also conform to one of the standards in subsection (1).
- (3) The department is authorized to negotiate a contract with the vendor selected to implement the electronic authentication feature which provides that the vendor pay all costs of implementing the system. This contract must not conflict with current contractual arrangements for the issuance of driver's licenses.
