5 (2) (a) PRECINCT-LEVEL ELECTION RESULTS.-Within 30 45 days 6 after certification by the Elections Canvassing Commission the 7 date of a presidential preference primary election, a special 8 election, primary election, or a general election, the 9 supervisors of elections shall collect and submit to the 10 department precinct-level election results for the election in a 11 uniform electronic format specified by paragraph (c) the department. The precinct-level election results shall be 12 compiled separately for the primary or special primary election 13

"All ballots cast" means ballots 20 21 cast by voters who cast a ballot whether at a precinct location, 22 by absentee ballot including overseas absentee ballots, during 23 the early voting period, or by provisional ballot.

24 (b) The department shall make such information available on 25 a searchable, sortable, and downloadable database via its website that also includes the file layout and codes. The 26 27 database shall be searchable and sortable by county, precinct, 28 and candidate. The database shall be downloadable in a tab-29 delimited format. The database shall be available for download 30 county-by-county and also as a statewide file. Such report shall 31 also be made available upon request.

32 (c) The files containing the precinct-level election 33 results shall be created in accordance with the applicable file 34 specification:

35 <u>1. The precinct-level results file shall be created or</u> 36 <u>converted into a tab-delimited text file.</u>

37 <u>2. The row immediately before the first data record shall</u> 38 <u>contain the column names of the data elements that make up the</u> 39 <u>data records. There shall be one header record followed by</u> 40 <u>multiple data records.</u>
