House Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States, urging Congress to submit the repeal amendment to the United States Constitution to the states for ratification.

WHEREAS, the United States Constitution provides for a government with enumerated powers, and

8 WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the United States 9 Constitution provides that "[t]he powers not delegated to the 10 United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the 11 States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the 12 people," and

WHEREAS, the balance of power in the federal system has shifted decidedly in favor of the powers of the Federal Government over the last century as a result of constitutional amendments and changes in judicial interpretation of constitutional limitations on the powers of the Federal Government, and

WHEREAS, the proposed repeal amendment would provide "[a]ny provision of law or regulation of the United States may be repealed by the several states, and such repeal shall be effective when the legislatures of two-thirds of the several states approve resolutions for this purpose that particularly describe the same provision or provisions of law or regulation to be repealed," and

26 WHEREAS, adoption of this amendment to the United States 27 Constitution would restore the original balance in our federal 28 system and allow a check on the Federal Government by the
