Section 23. Section 101.043, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

101.043 Identification required at polls.-

9 (1)(a) The precinct register, as prescribed in s. 98.461, 10 shall be used at the polls for the purpose of identifying the 11 elector at the polls <u>before</u> prior to allowing him or her to 12 vote. 15	<u>1.(a)</u> Florida driver's license.
16	2.(b) Florida identification card issued by the Department
17	of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
18	<u>3.(c)</u> United States passport.
19	<u>4.(d)</u> Debit or credit card.
20	<u>5.<del>(</del>e)</u> Military identification.
21	<u>6.(f)</u> Student identification.
22	7.(g) Retirement center identification.
23	8.(h) Neighborhood association identification.
24	<u>9.(i)</u> Public assistance identification.
25	(b) If the picture identification does not contain the
26	signature of the <u>elector</u> <del>voter</del> , an additional identification
27	that provides the <u>elector's</u> <del>voter's</del> signature shall be required.
28	The address appearing on the identification presented by the
29	elector may not be used as the basis to confirm an elector's
30	legal residence or otherwise challenge an elector's legal
31	residence. The elector shall sign his or her name in the space
32	provided on the precinct register or on an electronic device
33	provided for recording the <u>elector's</u> <del>voter's</del> signature. The
34	clerk or inspector shall compare the signature with that on the
35	identification provided by the elector and enter his or her
36	initials in the space provided on the precinct register or on an
37	electronic device provided for that purpose and allow the
38	elector to vote if the clerk or inspector is satisfied as to the
39	identity of the elector.
40	(c) Once a person has presented his or her voter
41	identification card and picture identification to the clerk or
42	inspector, the person may not be asked to provide additional

44	(2) If the elector fails to furnish the required
45	identification, the elector shall be allowed to vote a
46	provisional ballot. The canvassing board shall determine the
